Check-In

Managers & Coaches...

There is no on-site check-in. Your team's mandatory on-line check-in should be completed by this time to remain eligible for the event.

If you have not completed check-in, please contact us immediately as to why it is not complete. Failure to complete check-in could result in disqualification.

Managers...Be sure and stop by the main administration tent at any one of the venues during the weekend to pick up your Vegas Cup participation bag!

FAQ's & Additional Info:

- Please check your game schedules, as there is always the possibility of movement within the schedule. Make sure to refresh your browser and verify your game schedules.
- We do not supply tents on the sidelines, as we are not allowed to stake the tents on City fields. You are welcome to bring pop-up tents of your own...Please do **not** stake anything into the fields.
- Player Seating will be provided at Bettye Wilson, James Regional & Kellogg/Zaher
- Vegas Cup Fan Gear-All the latest designs will be available at all venues.
- Referees will provide game cards,
- Referee fees are included...You do not pay referee fees at the event.
- Home Team is responsible for providing game balls.
- Home Team is to wear white/light uniforms.
- If the referee declares a uniform color conflict, the HOME team will change uniforms.

- Home side of the field is the East or North side. Visitors side of the field is West or South side.
- No two teams will play from the same side of the field. Fans/spectators will occupy the same side of the field as their team, which will be clearly marked; HOME and AWAY
- Managers...Have your individual player cards with you at all games. If you are using digital cards, please print multiple copies of the roster or cards, with player photos, to have at each game.
- Any pre-existing injuries in need of pre-wrap or tape...Please try to deal with these prior to arrival to the fields. The medical staff will not always be able to handle requests for wrapping of pre-existing injuries or taping for preventative purposes.
- Heading the ball is only **allowed** in all 9v9 & 11v11 matches. Heading the ball is **prohibited** in 7v7 matches.
- There will be NO "Build-Out" lines...Punting is allowed.
- Teams are **NOT** permitted to roster an individual player on more than one team for the event. Under no circumstances can a team use a player on more than one team for this event. Teams found with players rostered or playing on more than one team will be disqualified by a forfeit of all games...**NO EXCEPTIONS.**
